WinSport's ski and snowboard hill closed Wednesday & Thursday due to cold

CALGARY, Alta. – WinSport announced today that the ski and snowboard hill at Canada Olympic Park will be closed to the public on Wednesday, Feb. 22, and Thursday, Feb. 23, due to forecasted cold temperatures and high wind chills.

Environment Canada is calling for highs only near the -23C range on Wednesday, with a wind chill of -31C in the morning and -36C in the afternoon. Thursday's forecasted high is -24C.

The hill is open today from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m.

A decision on Friday's opening will be determined on Wednesday. Park users are reminded to check www.winsport.ca for the latest hill updates.

Please note that the Markin MacPhail Centre remains in full operation.
