- From Dec. 21 to Jan. 5, daily operations will follow weekend hours, except for Christmas Day when the park is closed.

- Open to everyone aged 4 and up (minimum height: 91 cm / 36").
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Helmets are recommended for all riders—bring your own or rent one onsite.
